(+5 pts.)

Formatting:

- A headline in boldface, with a subject, verb and object that summarize the main content, is submitted as part of the beat.

3 pts.

- The author's name as a shirt-tail appears at the end of the beat one space after the period in this form:

By First Name Last Name

Example: By John Smith

3 pts.

News Value/Angle:

- The focus of the beat is to preview upcoming events rather than covering old news. There is some sort of timely angle to the beat.

10 pts.

- The beat leaves no unanswered reader questions and is long enough to provide details of the news; it is obvious the reporter has "thought like a reader," anticipating questions the reader would have and having sources answer those questions.

5 pts.

Reader Interest:

- The story puts a "face" on the news and shows how it will impact students. Effectively answers the questions "How will this affect me?" and "Why is this important?"

5 pts.

Sources:

- The beat has attribution, with at least two sources credited and obvious to the reader (one of whom is an "expert" to lend credibility).

5 pts.

- All names and references to those names (title, spelling) are accurate.

4 pts.

- If plausible, reporter has avoided using sources in his same grade.

5 pts.

Style:

- The entire beat is written in proper style (no more than two errors) and follows all of the style manual rules.

5 pts.

- The beat follows all spelling and grammar rules (including passive voice and agreement).

5 pts.

Other required elements (can only lose points here):

- Photo and cutline: Well-composed, in-focus, cutline follows style guidelines
- Hyperlink: Included, links to relevant content
- Spacing: Double-spaced, indents using "tab" key
- Email req's: Subject line, in-line text, attachments included
