So, now you know a few things about your subject from the Me In A Nutshell interview. Let's take what you know and use that to create a portrait.

Keep these things in mind:

- Lighting is key. If your person has more of a brooding personality, don't force them to pose outside in a field of flowers unless you can pull off the irony.

- Setting should suit the personality. If they are an outdoor person you won't capture anything true by keeping them inside.

- What about their personality? You can find creative ways to show that as well. Look back over their answers and think about poses or objects or locations that might be symbolic or representative.

Now, go shoot that photo! Then come back and answer these questions:

Why did you choose the location you chose?

Why did you pose your person like you did?

Did you feel at ease?

Did your subject feel at ease?

What could have been done to make it better?
